# Notes on Liberal Arts and Sciences Courses

## Precautions for Course Registration

- 1. All courses from the Liberal Arts and Sciences Class Timetable Table B have a registration code; that is, a seven-digit number starting from 00. These codes are extremely important as far as course registration is proceeded. Please be extremely careful with the codes when registering courses.
- 2. Syllabus can be accessed from <u>NU portal</u> → Student affairs → Course registration and grading → Syllabus
- 3. Course details such as instructors, type of classes (online, in-person, etc.), or classrooms may be changed without prior notice. Accordingly, you should regularly check NU portal, ILAS tab. (Updated information will be indicated in red.)
- 4. As any changes in course instructor and other related matters could result in a syllabus or timetable change, you are advised to confirm the latest information via <a href="NU portal">NU portal</a>, ILAS tab. For the course registration, you should make sure that your information is fully updated. (Updated information will be indicated in red.)
- 5. The number of credits required by your school for advancement and graduation may vary depending on the year of your enrollment. You are advised, therefore, to fully read the course conditions and procedures described in the Liberal Arts and Sciences Course Registration Guide of your enrollment year.
