

## Notes on Timetables for Liberal Arts and Sciences Courses (AY2025)

The Liberal Arts and Sciences Class Timetable consists of two timetables: “Timetable A”, which provides a general outline, and “Timetable B”, which provides detailed class schedules.

### Precautions for Course Registration

1. Liberal Arts and Sciences Class Timetable – Table B includes registration codes, seven-digit number starting from 00. These codes are extremely important to proceed with course registration. Please make sure to check the codes when registering for courses.
2. Please make sure to check the ILAS website (<https://office.ilas.nagoya-u.ac.jp/news/G30/>) regularly for course details such as instructors, term/day/period, lecture rooms, etc. It will be updated as needed, so you are advised to confirm the latest information. Please note that you can find the instructor's email address on each syllabus.
3. Syllabi for Liberal Arts and Sciences Courses can be accessed through the NU portal (<https://portal.nagoya-u.ac.jp/>).
4. The number of credits required for advancement and graduation may vary depending on the year of your enrollment. You are advised, therefore, to fully read the course conditions and procedures described in the “Students' Guide” and “Course Registration Procedures” of your enrollment year.
